- Financial Discussion
  - o 2024 Review
    - The balance sheet presented current bank balances:

• Operating: \$4,426.09

• Reserve: \$116,974.85

Accounts receivable: \$7,000

- Accounts Receivable (A/R):
  - Majority of A/R pertains to delinquent dues from one unit.
- Accounts Payable:
  - The main concern is the ~\$8,000 bill from Greenscapes, which could not be paid last Friday due to a funds shortfall. Farmers Grove currently has \$3,376 in operating funds.
  - Discussion on the need to borrow from the reserve fund to cover the bill;
    recommendation made to pay from reserve and reimburse from operating funds.
  - CD recently matured. AE will confirm from previous records ....
- Annual Budget Comparative
  - Year-end reconciled reports from SRG show an operating deficit of \$8,000, primarily due to overspending on grounds and landscaping, snow plowing, trash, and legal services.
- Easement Agreement
  - o A/R funds should be transferred to reserves upon receipt.
  - Allison, a board member, is to draft a letter to accompany the invoice packet, which includes the SRG invoice and supporting documents for the 20% agreement.
